WHEREAS, Dunes City land use codes do not allow the removal of vegetation in the Riparian Corridor, defined as the first Fifty (50) feet from the bank inland; and

WHEREAS, Dunes City land use codes do not allow the excavation, grading, fill, stream alteration or diversion, or removal of native vegetation, except for fire protection purposes, in the Riparian Corridor; and

WHEREAS, Responsible Party, Jack Thomas Claycomb has not complied with Case No. 2024.13.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** The Code Enforcement Officer of Dunes City hereby finds that violations exist as defined in Chapter 155 of the Dunes City Code in that:

- 1. Jack Thomas Claycomb is the owner of the property located at 5104 Ford Way, bearing Map and Tax Lot Number19-12-14-00-00900, as evidenced by Statutory Warranty Deed dated March 17, 2022, and recorded in the Lane County Deeds & Records as Document Number 2022-013993, on March 28, 2022, attached hereto as Exhibit A. and incorporated by reference herein, and that such property is situated within the incorporated City Limits of Dunes City;
- 2. On Monday June 17, 2024, Dunes City Permit Technician, Pamela Palmer, received a telephone complaint message stating that Jack Thomas Claycomb was having a tree cut by someone with a lift truck to take the top of the tree; and
- 3. On Tuesday July 16, 2024, Dunes City Permit Technician, Pamela Palmer, investigated and found that a tree had been cut in the riparian area without a permit as evidenced in pictures attached hereto as exhibit B and incorporated by reference herein; and
- 4. As of September 5, 2024, Responsible Party, Jack Thomas Claycomb has not complied with Code Enforcement Case No. 2024.13.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- Jack Thomas Claycomb is the property owner of the property located at 5104 Ford Way, bearing Map and Tax Lot Number 19-12-14-00-00900, is the person in charge of the property in which a Code violation exists, and is the person who caused the Code Violation to come into or continue to in existence, and, therefore, is a Responsible Party in this matter in that Section 36.010 of the Dunes City Code of Ordinances defines the "Personal Responsible" as:
  - "(a) The owner of the property on which a Code violation exists.

- "(b) The person in charge of the property in which a Code violation exists.
- "(c) The person who causes the Code Violation to come into or continue in existence."
- 2. Jack Thomas Claycomb, is the Responsible Party as defined in Title XIV, Chapter 141, entitled "Erosion and Sediment Control", Section 141.002, which states, in part:

### "Responsible Party:

- "A. A person or entity holding fee title to a property, tenant, lessee, or a person or entity who is acting as an owner's representative including any person, company, nonprofit organization or other entity performing services that are contracted, subcontracted, or obligated by other agreement to meet the requirements of this Code."
- 3. Chapter 154, entitled Soil Erosion Control and Vegetation Removal, Section 154.02, Definitions, of the Dunes City Code of Ordinances defines Shoreland Zone as:

"The shoreland zone includes all lands within 50 feet measured horizontally from the ordinary highwater line of all lakes and below.

- 4. Section 154.03 of the Dunes City Code of Ordinances states:
  - "(A) Generally
- "(1) A vegetation removal permit is required if any vegetation/tree is to be removed from the shoreland zone or riparian corridor, except as provided in (B)(1)(a) through (c) below.
- "(2) No vegetation shall be removed under a vegetation removal permit except as follows:
- "(a) Vegetation within 15 feet of the ordinary highwater mark in the shoreland zone or the top of the bank in riparian corridors may be removed if necessary for the development of water-dependent or water-related uses.
- "(b) 1. As much as 25% of the "original vegetation inventory" of the land area in any shoreland zone or riparian corridor that is more than 15 feet but less than 50 feet from the ordinary water line may be trimmed or cleared of natural vegetation with an approved vegetation removal permit provided that such action will not result in soil erosion.
- "2. The "original vegetation inventory" is to be determined by county stumps and other evidence of prior vegetation removal, based on what has been removed and what is growing. (The intent of this is to prevent subsequent property owners from each taking 25% until the shoreland could be stripped.)
- "(c) Vegetation which must be removed in conjunction with development otherwise allowed in the shoreland zone and riparian corridor.

- "(B) Exceptions to permit requirement.
  - "(1) A vegetation removal permit it not required for:
    - "(a) periodic maintenance as defined in Section 154.02;
- "(b) Removal of non-native vegetation or noxious weeds such as tansy-ragwort, Canadian thistle, gorse, or wild Scotch broom;
- "(c) Any tree that is determined to be a sudden or immediate threat to life structures, or property."
- 5. Jack Thomas Claycomb, failed or refused to apply for a permit to do work or remove vegetation in the shoreline zone of the property and, consequently, are in violation of the provisions of Section 154.03 of the Dunes City Code of Ordinances.
- 6. The disturbance or removal of vegetation was done by Jack Thomas Claycomb, the Responsible Party within 100 horizontal feet of the highwater mark of Woahink Lake and an area of wetlands located near the residential structure located on the property.
- 7. Chapter 36 of the Dunes City Code establishes the duties, responsibilities and authorities granted to the City Code Enforcement Officer and grants such Officer a variety of means for resolving violations of Dunes City Code. Section 36.070 states:

"In the event of a finding of a violation of the Code, the Code Enforcement Officer may take the following actions:

- "A. Seek voluntary compliance to abate the violation without any further action being taken;
- "B. Summarily abate the violation if the violation is an immediate threat to public health and safety or endangers property;
- "C. Impose administrative costs against the person found to be responsible for the violation;
  - "D. Issue a notice of violation;
  - "E. Issue a cease-and-desist order;
  - "F. Abate;
  - "G. Fine;
  - "H. Execute a stipulation agreement; and/or
  - "I. Commence civil proceedings."

- 14. Section 36.90 of the Dunes City Code of Ordinances addresses Abatement or Correction of a violation, the assessment of costs, and that all costs incurred by the City will be placed as a lien against the property. Section 36.90(H) thereof states:
- "H, Abatement or correction of a code violation is not a penalty, but is an additional remedy. Imposition of a penalty for a code violation does not relieve the Person or Persons Responsible of the duty to abate or correct the violation."

### 15. Section 36.095(A) states:

"A Any person found to be in violation of any section or provision of this City Code, where no other penalty is set forth, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for any one offense, each day constituting a separate offense."

## ORDER FOR CORRECTIVE ACTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF FINE

### **ORDER**

It is hereby ORDERED that Responsible Party, Jack Thomas Claycomb, take or cause to be taken, the following corrective action:

1. Pay a fine in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) a day with each day constituting a separate offense as of August 21, 2024. If the fine is unpaid as of September 30, 2024, the debt may be sent to private collections. If this debt is sent to collections, a debt collection fee of 20% will be added to the debt.

Failure to comply with this Order may result in the Code Enforcement Officer pursuing further administrative and judicial enforcement actions, including assessments of fines, abatement, and the filing of criminal charges.

NOTICE: THE PERSONS RESPONSIBLE, OR THE OWNERS OF THE PROPERTY, MAY APPEAL THIS ORDER FOR CORRECTIVE ACTION TO THE DUNES CITY COUNCIL BY DELIVERING A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR REVIEW TO THE CITY RECORDER WITHIN TEN (10) CALENDAR DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND THE PAYMENT OF ALL REQUISITE APPEAL FEES. IF THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE OR THE PROPERTY OWNER FAILS TO TIMELY FILE A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR REVIEW, THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S FINDING THAT A VIOLATION HAS OCCURRED WILL BE FINAL.
