## CITY OF DUNES CITY RESOLUTION SERIES 2020, NO. 4

## A Resolution Declaring the City of Dunes City to be a Second Amendment Preservation City in the State of Oregon

**WHEREAS**, the Second Amendment of the United States was ratified in December of 1791, shortly after the colonists defeated the British army and ended the rule of King George the III; and

**WHEREAS**, the Second Amendment states: "A well-regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms shall not be infringed."; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Dunes City considers the confiscation of legally owned and possessed firearms of any citizen to be unconstitutional; and

**WHEREAS**, the duly elected officials of Dunes City will not assist in any fashion any local, State or Federal agency in the unconstitutional confiscation of firearms from any resident of Dunes City, Oregon; and

**WHEREAS**, no employee of the City of Dunes City will assist in any fashion any local, State or federal agency in the unconstitutional confiscation of firearms from any resident of Dunes City, Oregon; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Dunes City, Oregon affirm support of the Lane County Sheriff Department to exercise sound discretion against enforcement of any unconstitutional firearms laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Dunes City, Oregon, hereby oppose the enactment of any legislation that would infringe upon the rights of the people to keep and bear arms and consider such laws to be unconstitutional and beyond lawful legislative authority;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNES CITY THAT:

Dunes City, Oregon does hereby declare itself to be a Second Amendment Preservation City in the State of Oregon.

This Resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
